**QUALIFICATION:** In order to qualify for a parking permit, you must possess a current and valid driver's license and proof of insurance. At the time you register for a parking permit, **you must provide a copy of your license, vehicle registration(s) and proof of insurance.** In the event of an accident involving your car, your registration and insurance information will be provided to law enforcement agencies and/or to the owner(s) of any other vehicle(s) involved in the accident **ALL SCHOOL OBLIGATIONS AND FEES MUST BE PAID IN FULL PRIOR TO APPLYING FOR A PARKING PERMIT.**

**DRUGS/ALCOHOL/ILLEGAL CONTRABAND/WEAPONS\***

**ALL** vehicles on CCPS property are subject to the same rules and regulations relative to search and seizure procedures as are student lockers. Refer to CCPS Policy for further reference.

Please familiarize yourself with the **THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT ACCEPTING A PARKING PERMIT** (attached). To maintain your privilege of parking on school property you must adhere to the guidelines set forth. Be sure to read and discuss this information with your parent(s)/guardian(s).

**\*Weapons on School Property:**

A student shall not possess, handle, or transmit any object that can reasonably be considered a weapon. Penalty-ranging from suspension to expulsion.

The following are considered weapons and explosives:

**Firearms:** Handguns, rifles, shotguns, bomb, starter pistols, grenades, rockets, .32 caliber gun, missile, .22 semi-automatic

**Other Guns:** flare gun, paint gun, glue gun, BB gun, paint ball gun, nail gun, pellet gun, look-alikes

**Other Weapons:** knife, pocket knife, stick, brass knuckles, tool knife blade, wooden club, switch blade, hammer, razor, box cutter, exacto knife, Swiss army knife, scissors, hypodermic needle, steak knife, awl, metal fingernail file, sling shot, razor blade, screw driver, lock blade knife, broom handle, metal pole, poison, Bowie knife, throwing star, pepper spray, metal knuckles, nunchakus, dart, laser pointer

**Explosives:** Exploding pen, firecrackers, gun shells, poppers, bullet, gas odor bomb, Molotov cocktail, dry ice in bottle, model rocket, fuel, butane lighters, shotgun shells, smoke bomb, stink bomb, M-80, cherry bomb

**THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT ACCEPTING A PARKING PERMIT**

**A PARKING PERMIT IS A PRIVILEGE AND NOT A RIGHT.**

All students who park a motor vehicle on the school campus must display the current permit which is a hanging parking tag. The parking tag must be hung from the rear-view mirror.

IMMEDIATELY report any changes on this application to the school manager or main office secretary.

Leaving campus without administration's permission (ex. Cutting class, leaving for lunch, etc.) will result in **forfeiting** your parking permit.

If you transport a student who is leaving without administration's permission, you will **forfeit** your parking permit. (It is your responsibility to know.)

Truancy and/or unexcused tardiness will result in forfeiting your parking permit.

Parking spaces are available on a "first come, first serve" basis. ALL VEHICLES MUST BE PARKED PARALLEL BETWEEN THE LINES AND OCCUPY ONLY ONE (1) PARKING SPACE.

Students may not park in any area other than student parking (ex. unauthorized use of handicapped parking). Students are not to park in the staff parking lot (this includes visitor spaces) from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. **Failure to follow these rules may result in your vehicle being towed (at owner's expense) and forfeiture of your parking permit.**

Any car that you park on school property must be listed on your permit application and must have your parking tag properly displayed. In cases of EMERGENCY ONLY, if you must park without a properly displayed parking tag, see the main office secretary before first period. (**"I forgot my permit, "I left it in another vehicle", etc. ARE NOT EMERGENCIES.**) Your parking tag must be visible from the outside of the vehicle.

Drive **10 mph or less** in school parking areas and school roadway.

Reckless driving, revving of engines, spinning wheels, blowing horns or any other forms of disruptive behavior will result in immediate suspension of your parking permit. If necessary, the police will be notified.

All students who drive to school and wish to park in the school lot must observe reasonable care in the use of the lot. Drivers who do not exercise proper caution, control speed, and park properly will be denied the use of the school parking lot.

**Students are not to drive through the bus lanes at any times.** During dismissal times, students are to yield to the buses. Once buses begin leaving the school parking lot, students must wait for all buses to depart before leaving the student parking lot.
